Dear Sir SAVILLE:

I have the honour to refer to Article II of the Financial Agreement signed at Ottawa on March 6, 1957, to amend the Financial Agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of the United Kingdom (March 6, 1946). This Article provides that the Agreement shall become effective at such time as shall be agreed upon by the two Governments. Accordingly, on behalf of the Government of Canada, I propose that the amending Agreement come into force on April 29, 1957. If this is acceptable to the Government of the United Kingdom, I further propose that this letter and your reply to that effect shall constitute the agreement between our two Governments provided for in Article II of the amending Agreement.
