

A native of Quebec City, Louis Berlinguet is a biochemist and educator. He is Vice-Chairman for Research at the University of Quebec, and President of the National Institute for Scientific Research in Quebec. He has been a member of the France-Quebec subcommittee on scientific and technological research since 1970, the committee on grants and scholarships of the National Research Council, and the governing body of the Institute of Microbiology and Hygiene since 1972, and the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada since 1973. Mr. Berlinguet is the author of numerous works on the biochemistry of proteins and cancer. He has been a member of the IDRC Board of Governors since 1970.
