

And also,—Return to an Order of the House of the 12th February, 1934, for a copy of all the evidence and the report of the commissioner, in connection with the enquiry into the charges of partisanship against Eugene Anglehart, postmaster at Kelly, Bonaventure County.

Mr. Matthews, a Member of the King's Privy Council, presented,—Return to an Order of the House of the 5th February, 1934, for a copy of all letters, correspondence and other documents, and a copy of reports made on Charles Theodore A. Hart, formerly an employee of the Department of National Revenue, Income Tax Branch, concerning his activities as an employee of the Government in Drummondville, Quebec.

Order in Council, P.C. 292, dated 14th February, 1934: authorizing payment to the Province of Nova Scotia of the sum of \$327.57 for municipal direct relief.

Order in Council, P.C. 294, dated 14th February, 1934: authorizing payment to the Province of Nova Scotia of the sum of \$19,347.27 for municipal direct relief.

Order in Council, P.C. 295, dated 14th February, 1934: authorizing payment to the Province of New Brunswick of the sum of \$9.56 for municipal direct relief.

Order in Council, P.C. 296, dated 14th February, 1934: authorizing payment to the Province of New Brunswick of the sum of \$3,567.52 for municipal direct relief.

Order in Council, P.C. 297, dated 14th February, 1934: authorizing payment to the Province of Ontario of the sum of \$10,000 towards the construction of the Haliburton-Eagle Lake Road.

Order in Council, P.C. 298, dated 14th February, 1934: authorizing payment to the Province of Ontario of the sum of \$85.34 for municipal and provincial direct relief.

Order in Council, P.C. 299, dated 14th February, 1934: crediting the sum of \$1,260.59 to the loan made to the Province of Manitoba under authority of P.C. 2443, dated November 28, 1933, respecting freight on fodder in Manitoba drought area, P.C. 2384, dated November 28, 1933.

Order in Council, P.C. 300, dated 14th February, 1934: crediting the sum of \$39,091.09 to loan made to the Province of Saskatchewan under authority of Order in Council, P.C. 2439, dated November 24, 1933, for municipal direct relief.

Order in Council, P.C. 301, dated 14th February, 1934: authorizing payment to the Province of Alberta of the sum of \$18.73 for municipal direct relief and transients.

Order in Council, P.C. 302, dated 14th February, 1934: authorizing payment to the Province of Alberta of the sum of \$416.10 for movement of not more than twenty families from Turner Valley District for settlement in Northern Alberta.

Order in Council, P.C. 303, dated 14th February, 1934: crediting the sum of \$171,179.93 to loans made to the Province of British Columbia for municipal direct relief, provincial direct relief, disorganized or bankrupt municipalities and for transient families.
