PRAYERS.

The following Government Notice of Motion having been called was transferred to Government Orders for consideration at the next sitting of the House, pursuant to Standing Order 21(2):

That it is expedient that the Houses of Parliament approve the Agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of Saskatchewan respecting the South Saskatchewan River Project, signed on the 25th of July, 1958, and that this House do approve the same.—*Minister of Agriculture.*

On motion of Mr. Fisher, seconded by Mr. Regier, it was ordered,—That an humble Address be presented to His Excellency the Governor General praying that he will cause to be laid before this House a copy of all correspondence since September 1, 1957, between the Minister of Transport and the Shipping Federation of Canada on pilotage and associated matters.—(**Notice of Motion No. 32.*)

On motion of Mr. Fisher, seconded by Mr. Howard, it was ordered,—That an humble Address be presented to His Excellency the Governor General praying that he will cause to be laid before this House a copy of all correspondence since September 1, 1957, between the Minister of Transport and the Dominion Marine Association, on pilotage and associated matters.
