Replying to you HQ. 7429-17-1
dated April 25th, I have to state as follows:

In the Faculty of Arts and also in the third and fourth years of the Faculty of Applied Science provision is made in this University for students who desire to take military instruction by offering alternate courses.

On the other hand, in the first two years of the course in the Faculty of Applied Science the curriculum is very crowded and it has been found necessary to make it rigid and uniform for students in all departments of Engineering. There are no alternatives offered and if any students in these first two years of this Faculty desire to obtain military education they must take it as an extra subject.

Mount Allison and Acadia Universities are affiliated with McGill so far as the first two years in the Faculty of Applied Science are concerned. Their course is, consequently, identical with ours and there is no opportunity at present for offering alternatives in either.
