

reach their destination in less than fifty days from the time of their embarkation. The voyage from Boston into Campeachy bay is, generally, less than twenty-five days. Over the isthmus, by means of carriages, would be less than two days. From Panama gulf to the entrance of the Columbia river is a voyage of about twenty days. The other Map is a representation of Oregon, made from the best authorities.

#### NOTATIONS.

The numerical figures are used for references from the description of an object in the book, to the representation of it, on the map; for example, the figure 1, under the head of Lewis' river, refers to Drewyer's river on the map.

= Two parallel lines drawn across the river indicate a fall.

~ A crooked line across a river indicates a rapid.

^ Two sides of a triangle indicate an Indian village, and the figure included is the reference.
