ing to the fund.

SEC. 21.—Any member whose original certificate shall become torn, lost, or destroyed, on producing satisfactory evidence thereof, shall be

supplied with a duplicate on payment of 25 cents.

SEC. 22.—In case of a death occurring immediately after the organization of this fund, or before sufficient money has accumulated to paythe amount of the claim, the beneficiary shall receive only the aggregate of three months' assessment for the total membership.

SEC. 23.—As soon as the membership has reached 500 and has had an existence of six months' duration, the full claim of the beneficiary will be recognized. If sufficient money is not on hand, the Society claim the privilege of an extension of time beyond the forty days mentioned in Sec. 15.

SEC. 24.—The amount of bonds to be given by the Secretary and

Treasurer shall be fixed by the S. H. C. at its annual meetings. SEC. 25.—Any member of this fund who may have taken a beneficiary certificate for \$250, \$500, \$750 or \$1,000, and wishing to increase that amount shall be permitted to do so provided the first and second certificates shall not amount together to more than \$2,000; the applicant shall be required to pass a second Medical Examination, and be charged for such increased amount; the rate according to his age at the time of making the second application, and that a fee of one dollar be charged to cover the expense of the second application.
