12. 2d. Voted that a Church meeting be appointed, and Brethren chosen to visit, advise, admonish and exhort, in meekness and in much love, the above described Brethren: should their endeavours prove fruitless, it is our advice to exclude them.

13. Voted, that Brother *Hammond* be examined, as a Candidate for Ordination.
