

son and persons, grantees of the said Company, their heirs and assigns, held, granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed and disposed of, and may and shall pass by descent in such manner and form and upon and under such rules and restrictions in all respects as would have been the case if such lands tenements and hereditaments had been granted direct by His said Majesty, His heirs and successors, to any such person or persons, their heirs and assigns, to be holden in free and common soccage; and the said Company may do all other acts and things in relation to the affairs and business of the said Company in all respects as beneficially as any other body politic or corporate, or any subject of this realm is by law entitled to do.

And be it further Enacted, That it shall be lawful for any artificer, handicraftsman, clerk, mechanic, gardener, servant in husbandry or other labourer, not being under the age of Sixteen years, by Indenture duly executed, to contract with the said Company faithfully to serve or to proceed to and faithfully serve the said Company in any of the said Provinces and Colonies or their dependencies for any period not exceeding the full term of Seven years, to be computed from the day of the date of such Indenture.

And be it further Enacted, That when judgment shall at any time be obtained in any action, in any court or courts of law within the United Kingdom of *Great Britain* and *Ireland*, at the suit of any person or persons, bodies politic or corporate, against the said Company or their successors, an office copy of any such judgment, signed by the proper officer of the court in which the same shall be obtained, shall be received and registered in any court or courts of law in the said Provinces of *Lower Canada*, *Upper Canada*, *New Brunswick*, *Nova Scotia*, *Prince Edward's Island* and the Island of *Newfoundland*, in *North America*, or their dependencies, as full and conclusive evidence of such judgment; and that such writ or writs of execution may thereupon issue out of such court or courts in *North America*, at the suit of the plaintiff, against the said Company, and their assets be taken in execution, and such other proceedings be had under the said judgment in like manner as if judgment had been obtained against the said Company at the suit of such plaintiff, in the court or courts of law in which such office copy shall be so received and registered.
