## BILL.

## An Act to amend the Municipal and Assessment Acts of Upper Canada, in so far as they relate to the commutation of Statute Labour.

Whereas doubts exist as to the power of the Municipal Councils in Preamble. Upper Canada to increase the commutation for Statute Labour to more than two shillings and six pence per day; and whereas it is expedient to remove such doubts and to confer such power on the several Mun 5 icipal Councils; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

I. It shall be lawful for any Municipal Council in Upper Canada, by any Commutation By-law passed for that purpose, to fix the rate at which parties may common money for sta-10 mute their Statute Labour at any sum not exceeding five shillings, for tute labor may each days's labour, and the sum so fixed shall apply to residents, to all to five shill persons subject to Statute Labour, and to non-residents in respect to their lings. property, as provided in the Assessment Act of 1853.

II. Anything in the Assessment or Municipal Acts of Upper Canada Inconsistent to contrary to the provisions of this Act shall be and is hereby repealed.
