

An Act to amend the Acts relating to Land Surveyors.

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to amend the Act passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's reign, and intituled, *An Act to repeal certain Acts therein mentioned, and to make better provision respecting the admission of Land Surveyors and the survey of Lands in this Province*, and also the Act passed in the Session held in the fourteenth and fifteenth years of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, *An Act to amend the Act concerning Land Surveyors*, in the manner hereinafter mentioned : Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and intituled, *An Act to re-unite the Provinces of Upper and Lower Canada, and for the Government of Canada*, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the second section of the Act first cited in the preamble to this Act, and so much of the eighth section of the said Act as provides that so much of the sum therein required to be paid by each Applicant receiving a Certificate, as shall remain after paying the expenses (if any) attending the examination of such Applicant, shall be equally divided among those Members of the proper Board of Examiners who shall have attended the Examination, and shall not be salaried Officers of the Government, be and the same is hereby repealed; and that the remainder of any such sum, after paying the expenses (if any) attending the Examination, shall be paid over to the Commissioner of Crown Lands and accounted for by him in like manner with other moneys received by him, and it shall be lawful for the said Commissioner to pay to each Member of such Board attending any Examination and not being a salaried Officer of the Government, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ for each day's attendance, and to charge the same in his account as part of the expenses of his Office.

How the sum remaining after paying the expenses of the examination shall be dealt with, and how the Examiners shall be paid.

Penalty on persons not having licensed Surveyors who shall survey boundary lines.

II. And be it enacted, That no person shall, after the passing of this Act, survey the boundary lines of any lands for hire or profit within Upper Canada or Lower Canada, unless he shall be duly authorized to practise as a Land Surveyor according to the provisions of this Act, or shall have been so authorized before the passing thereof, according to the Laws then in force, under a penalty of *Ten pounds* currency for each offence, to be recovered by any person who shall sue for the same, in any Court having Civil Jurisdiction to the amount of such penalty, one moiety whereof shall belong to Her Majesty and make part of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of this Province, and the other moiety shall belong to the person suing for the penalty.
