BILL.

An Act to Incorporate The Orphans' Home and Female Aid Society, Toronto.

HEREAS an Association has been formed in the Preamble. City of Toronto under the name of "The Orphans' Home and Female Aid Society," for the purpose of affording relief and support to friendless orphans and destitute 5 females of the said City and of the County of York, and in addition thereto, to afford religious and moral instruction to all who may become dependant thereon; and whereas the Association is composed of the several persons hereinafter mentioned, who have by petition 10 prayed that they and their successors may be incorporated under certain regulations and provisions hereinafter mentioned: Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

That

and such other persons as shall under the provisions of Certain 15 this Act, become members of the said Institution, shall be persons incorporated. and are hereby declared to be a body politic and corporate, in deed and in name, by the name of "The Orphans' Corporate Home and Female Aid Society, Toronto," and by that name and rewards name shall have perpetual succession, and a common 20 seal, and shall have power from time to time to alter,

renew or change such common seal at their pleasure, and shall by the same name from time to time and at all times hereafter be able and capable to purchase, acquire, hold,

possess and enjoy, and to have, take and receive to them 25 and their successors to and for the uses and purposes of the said corporation, any land, tenements and hereditaments and real or immoveable property and estate Real property, situate, lying and being within this Province, not exceeding in yearly value the sum of one thousand pounds, cur-

30 rency, and the same to sell, alienate and dispose of, and to purchase others in their stead for the same purposes, and by the same name shall and may be able and capable in law to sue and be sued, implead and be impleaded, answer and be answered unto in all Courts of law and

35 places whatsoever in as large, ample and beneficial a manner as any other body politic or corporate, or as any persons able or capable in law may or can sue or be sued, implead or be impleaded, answer or be answered unto in any manner whatsoever, and shall have power and
