

form the said agreement and to execute such conveyance, and they have presented their petition praying that they may be so enabled.

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:—

The said parties may convey the said property in fee simple to the said Thomas Galt.

1. From and after the passing of this Act it shall and may be lawful for the said Alexander Donald Austin Æneas Macdonell, Margaret Isabella Macdonell and Amelia Helen (sometimes called Emily Ellen,) Macdonell, to convey and assure to the said Thomas Galt, his heirs and assigns for ever, in fee simple, the respective shares, interests and estates of them the said Alexander Donald Austin Æneas Macdonell, and Margaret Isabella Macdonell and Amelia Helen (sometimes called Emily Ellen) Macdonell, of and in the said parcel of land and premises and such conveyance or conveyances so to be made shall be and the same are hereby declared to be as good and effectual in the Law, to all intents and purposes whatsoever, as if the said Alexander Donald Austin Æneas Macdonell, Margaret Isabella Macdonnell and Amelia Helen (sometimes called Emily Ellen) Macdonell, were respectively at the time of making the same, of the full age of twenty-one year; any Law, custom or usage to the contrary thereof in anywise notwithstanding.

Public Act.

2. This Act shall be deemed a public Act.
