years after Mr. MacCosham's death.

The bequest is being treated as a donation to the Three Alberta Universities's Capital Fund. The project, a joint appeal by the U of A, the University of Calgary and the University of Lethbridge to non-governmental sources for capital support, was launched in 1968. It had a minimum objective of \$25 million to be obtained from private sources over a five-year period to help finance high priority projects at the universities.

All contributions from corporations, foundations, alumni and other friends of the universities were matched dollar-for-dollar by the provincial government, provided they were for capital projects which were approved by the Universities Commission.

The MacCosham bequest, payable in December, 1974, fell within the extended date of the five-year campaign limit.

A department of advanced education guideline states that funds raised for the purpose of increasing the stock of library books are eligible for matching by the department, providing the books can be used on a regular basis by students and staff.

The library at present has a collection of approximately 1,500,000 books and more than 16,000 periodicals.
