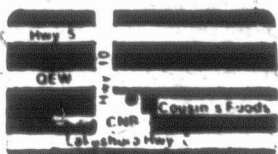

Queensway Hospital evacuated

Ambulatory patients at Queensway General Hospital got a surprise trip to the homes of friends and relatives last Sunday when 230 patients were transferred or temporarily released.

Kenneth Box, Queensway's administrative director, said Monday the hospital seemed a strange place after the patients had been taken out to various other hospitals.

"Nobody's around," he said. "It's an eerie feeling. I can never recall a hospital being evacuated," he added.

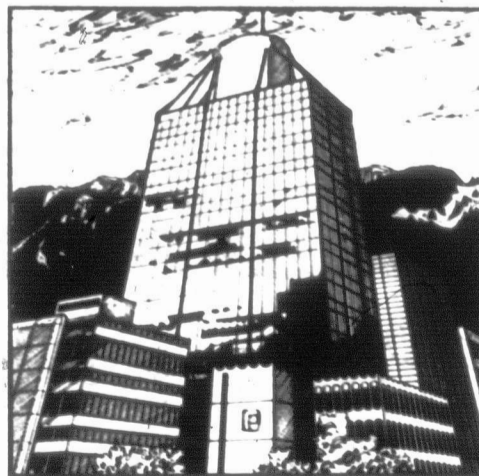
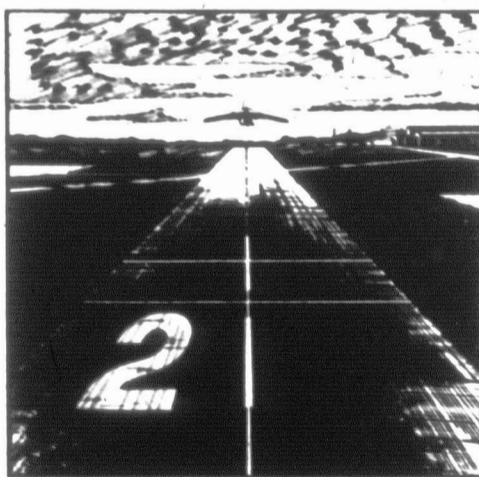
Box said the four-hour evacuation followed along the lines of a disaster plan hospital staff had been drilled in before.

"We have had practice in evacuating patients so this stood us in good stead," Box explained. "These are practice runs we do every once in a while."

Hospital staff and many volunteers helped move out the patients, informing relatives and organizing and transporting hospital records.

"We had 10 people in intensive care unit," the administrator said. "These were the people who gave us the most concern. We moved them first."
