He have Received yours of the 11th Instant where - by perceive that a number of 60 or 80 Ind attacqued a Small Forts at northfield that morning, we are concerned for the Lofs of the men they have killed and other mischief they have Done, you are pleased to Intimate that if a number of the 6 Nations together with Some of the River Indians were dispatched might probably arrive at Other Beek before the Enemy reach there and be capable of doing Service, We are of Enimon that if so or go Indians of the A Mations were in Town and had Canoes provisions and ammunition Ready and Immediately dispatched might probabely de some service, but as here are not above four or five young Indians; the Sending to their Settlements would take up fo much time in their Coming hither and getting ready for fuch an Enterprize that it would have no Effect, We hope your forces may have defated the Enemy we Remain with Refrect . fir
