

Sir,-

In reply to your letter of the 22nd ultimo, No. 902, I have to say that it may not be possible to send Mr. Green to your Agency this season. When a surveyor is sent to your Agency he will be instructed, if his other duties permit, to look into the question of bringing water for irrigation from Bridge Creek to the Canim Lake Indian reserve No. 1.

It is to be noted that no allotment of water from Bridge Creek has been recorded in favour of the said reserve or for either of the Canim Lake reserves. (See page 87 of the Schedule of Indian reserves) Before the expense of a survey is incurred you should ascertain if there is unappropriated water running in Bridge Creek and then make the necessary record of a reasonable quantity for the Indians. You may forward an account of the fees for the record to the Department for payment.
