

A Reserve.

A Reserve at the mouth of and on the left bank of Ashcroft Creek, on the right bank of the Thompson River being at present a cultivated Indian farm.

*. 30 inches of water from the spring now used by the Indians and from any other available source of water supply.

No. 100.

A Reserve consisting of the cultivated lands of the Indians on the left bank of the Thompson River, a short distance below Mr. Keefe's Willard's house.

*. 30 inches of water from all available sources of water supply.

Note this 30 inches of water were surrendered by Mr. Keefe on exchange for 30 acres of land on the left bank of the Thompson River just above the landing.

A Reserve of 500 acres situated near the left bank of the Thompson River and about 30 chains to the eastward of the No. 10 Reserve.

*. The surplus water of Nelson and Bernard Creeks is reserved for the use of the Indian on this and following allotment namely 1st A Reserve of 80 acres situated about 30 chains to the south of Reserve No. 6.
