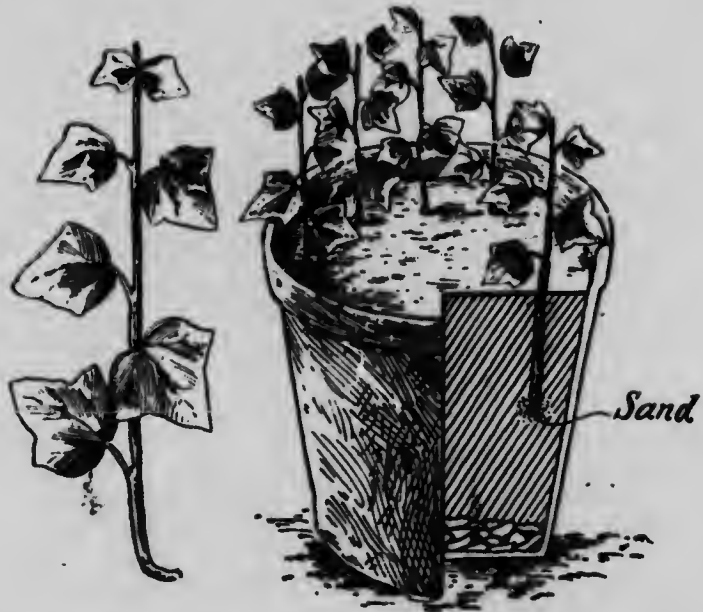

roots freely. The garden frame ought to be made full use of for this purpose, if an increased number of such plants is wanted.

Cuttings of Rockery Flowers.—If a bed of sand about 6 inches in depth is made up in the frame, so that its surface is within 3 or 4 inches of the glass, innumerable rockery plants may be increased by cuttings. They are inserted in the sand which is kept thoroughly moist, and the frame is closed and not shaded. The result is, of course, that the atmosphere inside the
