The Shire Sale

The sale of imported Shire horses, consigned by S. George MacKanes, of Northampton, Eng., held at Grand's Repository, Toronto, on October 7th, was fairly well attended, though some of the prominent Shire breeders in this district were conspicuous by their absence. The sale had been well advertised and it is to be regretted that a higher average was not obtained for this class of horses, a breed that is doing much for the building up of the horse breeding industry of this country.

There were nine sold, six stallions and three fillies. The quality of the whole was fair, some of the stallions showing a little more roughness about the legs than one would expect in an importation of this kind. The horses were not perhaps as well fitted and groomed as they might have been for sale purposes. However, they were a fairly good lot and at the prices sold should prove good investments for the purchasers. The following is a list of the animals sold with prices:
