

An Act for the Establishment of Fees, as regulated by  
the Governor and Council, at the Request of the  
*House of Assembly.*

B

*Be it enacted, by the Commander in Chief,  
the Council and Assembly, That the establishment  
of the Fees belonging to the several Offices in this  
Province, be as followeth,*

*Justices of Peace out of Court,*

<i>For every Writ or Summons, each Justice,</i>	<i>{ two shillings and six Pence.</i>
<i>Entering an action,</i>	<i>one shilling.</i>
<i>Execution</i>	<i>{ one shilling and four Pence.</i>
<i>Sending up Papers to the Inferior Court,</i>	<i>one shilling.</i>
<i>Subpœna for each Witness,</i>	<i>six pence.</i>
<i>Every Recognizance, each Person</i>	<i>one shilling.</i>
<i>Taking of Affidavits, each Person</i>	<i>one shilling.</i>
<i>Acknowledging an Instrument or Deed,</i>	<i>one shilling.</i>
<i>A Warrant in Trespass and Assault and Battery,</i>	<i>one shilling.</i>
<i>Every Examination in assault and Battery,</i>	<i>{ two shillings &amp; six pence.</i>

<i>Drawing an Indictment if found</i>	<i>{ two shillings and six pence.</i>
<i>Every Tryal and Judgment</i>	<i>five shillings.</i>
<i>Every Submission.</i>	<i>two shillings and six pence.</i>
<i>Concordatum Fee</i>	<i>one shilling and six pence.</i>
<i>Every Petition and Proceedings thereon,</i>	<i>two shillings and six pence.</i>
<i>Every Cause continued by Traverse or otherwise</i>	<i>{ one shilling.</i>
