Sudden Death of Mrs.  
Robert Garland—Other

PARIS, April 13.—The death took place early Sunday morning of Mrs. Robert Garland of St. Catharines, at the home of her sister, Mrs. H. Henstock, Paris Station. **Funeral of the Late John Armstrong.**  
The funeral took place yesterday afternoon of Mr. John Armstrong, who passed away on Friday in his 90th year. The late deceased came to Paris with his family at the age of 17, and for some years, worked in the Coleman and Curtis plaster mines adjoining Paris. Later the family moved to a farm in Brantford township, at present occupied by Mr. Clump. A few years after that the father of the deceased purchased 250 acres not far from the Clump property which remained in the Armstrong family ever since. For 10 years the subject of this sketch, with his family, resided in Australia. Upon returning to Canada he farmed in Burford, and later in London Tp. where his wife died and for the last 10 years he had made his home with his son, Mark, of Bantfield Street. He was only sick for a week and retained his faculties to the last. He also lived beneath five sovereigns. Rev. W. Reed conducted the services. He leaves to mourn his loss three sons and one daughter—Mark, E. of Paris; James of Sask.; Thomas of London and Mrs. C. D. McMeDon of Vancouver.
