By Courier Leased Wire Savannah, Ga., Dec. 3.-After hard fight with a terrific gale in which she lost her anchors and had her wheel smashed, the British steamer Amakura has arrived here from St. John, N.B. She left St. John December 22. Six hours out, according to her officers, she was struck by gale and attempted to make St. Mary's Bay, but failed. The anchor held for a few hours but finally the chain snapped and the vessel drifted in the wind, until the seas calmed. The crew suffered extremely from the cold.
