RAILROADS ADDITING THE NON DRINKING POLICY.

One more telling instance showing the stand being taken by great railroad and other corporations, as well as business concerns, in the matter of drinking among their employee is recorded in the recent step taken by James J. Hill, the great railroad finan cier. While the percentage of serious accidents and minor mishaps on the great western lines in his control has not been greater than on rival roads it has remained a matter of grave concern and presented a field for inquiry as to what amount was preventable waste. President Hill accordingly instituted a thorough investigation of the reasons for the cost of life, limb, damages, destroyed equipment, and delays. The result is the sending of this official warning to all the officers of the operating departments of the Great Northern and all the other Hill companies:

"We do not wish to have in our em-

Great Northern and all the other Hfill companies:

'We do not wish to have in our employ men who drink liquor. Do not employ drinking men, if men now working under you drink, tell them they must stop it or make room for men who will not drink.'

The Great Northern has thus 'gone dry' solely for economic reasons and the action demonstrates the same phase of materialism which actuated tens of thousands of southern nue who were unmoved by the moral argument for prohibition to vote the saloon out of their States and thus prevent an enormous amount of crime and add a measure of efficiency to their labor supply.
