

Y.M.C.A. Would Foster Hockey For Juveniles

Scheme of Organizing League For Boys 14 To 18 Will Meet With Favor

The Y. M. C. A. will come forth with a hockey team for the Interclub Hockey League idea to develop material from ages of 14 to 18 years of age, providing that such an organization can be formed.

Several of the social clubs of the city are also interested in the proposal of handling the youngsters, and a campaign may be conducted by the sub-committee of the L. A. A. to secure entries for the league.

The hockey sub-committee of the L. A. A. will have a busy session over the week-end, acting on the recommendations made at the open hockey meeting on Wednesday evening.

The hockey recruits joined in with the other members of the Y. M. C. A. classes at the gymnasium last evening, and next week will secure special hours at the gym. Sid Rankin, who has been appointed in charge of the pre-season training, urges every intermediate or junior hockey player to attend the workouts and get in shape for the hockey season, which will open in the matter of two weeks.
