A convincing fact of the great evils and expense resulting from the liquor traffic, is contained in the statement that out of 81 arrests made by the police in Quebec, resulting in 320 convictions, in 1886, 562 of the total arrests and 473 of the total convictions were for drunkenness, and 120 more for offences directly traceable to the liquor traffic.

The frightful railway accident reported in another column, that occurred in Tiffin, Ohio, on the 4th inst., is alleged to have been caused by the engineer of the freight train being under the influence of liquor. If there is one class of men more than another who should abstain from the use of liquor, it is the class of men who are engaged in the operation of a railway.

Lord Lansdowne, the Governor General of this Dominion, has been offered a seat in the English Cabinet, but has declined the honor at least for the present. He is a Liberal in politics but dissents from Gladstone's Irish policy, and retired from the government in 1880, because of a bill introduced in the House of Commons for the purpose of abolishing the office of Governor General.
