FOREIGN TRADE AND COMMERCE

In total value of trade, Canada normally ranks fifth, after the United States, West Germany, Britain and France. On a population basis, it usually ranks eighth.

Over 55 per cent of Canada's imports are fully-manufactured goods. Over half of Canada's imports enter duty-free. Exports, on the other hand, are mainly semi-manufactured products, finished products, raw materials and food products. These classifications account for almost four-fifths of total exports.

The total value of Canada's foreign trade has advanced each year since 1958. Since 1961, exports have exceeded imports in all but one year. Canadian trade with all countries in 1967 reached \$22.2 billion, and there was a trade surplus of \$31 million.

The main components of Canadian export trade, by stages of manufacture are fabricated materials, followed
