A limited number of participants will be selected. It is important, therefore, to present a well-defined and realistic training proposal.

### **Duration of traineeship**

Traineeships will be for a period of up to 10 months depending upon the trainee's needs and the offer made by the receiving employer.

### **Eligibility**

To be considered for this exchange, an applicant must:

- be a Canadian citizen;
- be between 18 and 30 years of age;
- have a current working knowledge of Spanish (a candidate who meets the eligibility factors and is selected as a

possible participant after an oral interview will be required to take a written and oral Spanish language test at that time); and

- possess a degree from a university or a diploma/certificate from an educational institute at the post-secondary level (or institute of technology, community college or CEGEP).
