We desire most of all a steady growth of universal institutions towards peace, sanity and the rule of law. We cannot sustain that growth unless we are completely convinced and proclaim vigorously our conviction that there are loyalties beyond nationalism. There is ample proof that this belief is strongly adhered to by many and that it can be given effective application. The measures taken to preserve and give more adequate expression to old friendships, the common committeent to principles and interests among allies extending far beyond national boundaries and the determination of states large and small to implement the provisions of the United Nations Charter are evidence of the strength of this conviction. We have begun to develop additional loyalties and to create new realms for the activities of man in his search for peace, security, and freedom.
