

Financial Administration Act

The Acting Speaker (Mr. Herbert): Order. It being 4:45 p.m., it is my duty, pursuant to Order made Wednesday, May 16, 1984, to interrupt proceedings and to put forthwith every question necessary to dispose of the second reading stage of the Bill now before the House.
