

by sale, loan, or gift; appoint a committee to enter-ent, and select Tracts for distribution; and assign to the Board and of the Society in obtaining subscriptions and usefulness of the Society, special meetings of the Society on their own vacancies. Three shall be chosen.

ART V. It shall be the duty of the Board to record the proceedings of the Board, notes of meetings, and the Annual Report, and to send a copy of the same to the British and Foreign Bible Society, and a notice of the same to the Board of the abstract of the same, and with a list of the names of the donors of the same to the Board.

ART. VI. The Treasurer shall report the state of the Treasury to the meeting of the Board; and shall, when directed, pay the funds to the Board, or to the parent institution, and procure the same to be published as ordered.

ART. VII. Meetings of the Society shall be opened by prayer.

ART. VIII. This Constitution may be altered by a vote of two-thirds of the members present at any meeting of the Society regularly convened.
