CHAP. VI.

Paul exhorteth to mildness, &c.

BRETHREN, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such a one in the spirit of meckness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.

- 2 Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of . Christ.
- 3 For if a man think himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceiveth himself.
- 4 But let every man prove his own work, and then shall he have rejoicing in himself alone, and not in another.
 - 5 For every man shall bear his own burden.
- 6 Let him that is taught in the word communicate unto him that teacheth in all good things.
- 7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.
