R. NORTON was born in Berlin, Connecticut, 1716; graduated at Yale College in 1737. Four years after, namely, in 1741, he was ordained in Fall Town, since Bernardston, Massachusetts, and was the first minister in

that town. Owing "to the unsettled state of the times," he continued in Fall Town but about four years; the people had quite as much as they could do to maintain their families, while they were exposed to inroads of the enemy in a war already commenced. The statement of his having been settled at Deerfield in 1741, is probably incorrect. After his return from captivity he was installed pastor of the Congregational church in East Hampton, Middlesex county, Connecticut, November 30th, 1748, where he continued about
