by him, shall immediately take his seat; but he may appeal from such order, and a majority of the members present may reverse it.

ARTICLE X.

In debate, no member shall be personal in his remarks.

ARTICLE XI.

All motions, if required by the chair, shall be made in writing, and read by the mover at his seat before offering.

ARTICLE XII.

Honorary Members. The Society may elect, as Honorary Members, such persons only as shall have rendered important services to the Society, or to the country; but no person shall be elected an Honorary Member who has not at some time resided in British Columbia.

ARTICLE XIII.

Bonds.

The Board of Directors shall fix the amount and approve the bonds of the Secretary and Treasurer, which bonds shall be placed in the possession of the President for safe keeping; and shall determine the compensation to be paid to the Secretary and Treasurer.

Auditing The Board of Directors shall constitute the Committees. Auditing Committee, and shall examine all ac-
