

GRIDIRON CAPTURES UP BILBERRY OVER JUMPS GET-AWAY AT HAMILTON

Manheimer, J. H. Reed and
Momentum Among the
Winners at Good Prices—
Great Crowd in Attendance.

HAMILTON, Oct. 10.—Getaway day was a disastrous one for the talent on the track this afternoon, but two out of the seven favorites winning. The feature event of the day, the fifth race, a mile and a quarter, was won by Gridiron and Chalfont.

The track was fast and the attendance nearly equal to that of opening day. Many of the stables which raced here will be shipped to-morrow to London, some to the Toronto half mile track and a few will go to Hamilton to rest up for the coming meeting at the Baltimore track.
