OTTAWA, Aug. 30.—Sir John Hendrie won two events today when he rode Seagram, an imported horse, came home first in the fourth race, and the same right back with Good Shot in the fifth, at one mile, for Canadian two-year-olds.

Seagram's entry ran one-two in the dash for Canadian juveniles, starting, which was making his first start, winning, with Sturdee, his stable-mate, second, and Bavarde third.
