New Compulsory Education
Law in Massachusetts, and

To enforce striotly the new school law affecting children employed in mills, factories and stores, which goes into effect today is the purpose of the state board of education. It is estimated that thousance of children chus employed may be forced to leave their employment to adquire the rudiments, at least of an education in English.

The important sections of the law as passed by the legislature of 1905 are as follows:

"No child under the age of 14 years of age who does not have a certificate as required by the following sections, certifying to the child's ability to read at sight and to write legisly simple sentences in the English language, shall be employed in any factory, workehop or mercantile establishment.
