6. The General Board shall make appropriations for all its work, and no special appeals shall be made to our Auxiliaries, but all our funds shall pass through the hands of Branch and Board Treasurers.

7. All solicitations for funds for special objects, excepting those legitimately belonging to the Supply Committee, before being introduced to the notice of our members, through any agency of this Society, shall be referred to, and receive the approval of, the proper authorities, namely, the Board or its Executive.

8. There shall be a Supply Committee consisting of four members appointed at the Annual Board Meeting, who shall have charge of all supplies of clothing, bedding, etc., contributed by the Auxiliaries and Young People's Societies, and who shall direct as to their destination. To avoid confusion, Auxiliaries, etc., must correspond with the Secretary-Treasurer of the Committee before sending goods to the Supply Committee or elsewhere.

9. There shall be a Literature and Publication Committee consisting of not more than seven members, resident in Toronto, who, with the Secretary-Treasurer of the Committee, shall be appointed by the Board. Orders for Annual Reports, *Monthly Letters* and *Leaflets* should be sent to the Literature Committee, Room 20, Wesley Buildings, Toronto, the money to accompany each order.

10. The Annual Meeting of the Board shall be held in the third week of October, leaving power with the President and Corresponding Secretary to postpone to the fourth if necessary.

11. Regular meetings of the Executive shall be held the third Wednesday in June and third Wednesday in April.

12. All expenses of the Annual Meetings of the Board and of meetings of the Executive, including all necessary travelling expenses, shall be paid from the General Fund.

13. All money received from legacies shall be used for special purposes, unless the object for which it is to be used be specified by the donor.

14. The printed or prepared forms issued by the General Board shall be used in all homes, refuges, schools, etc., supported or aided by the W. M. S., in order that proper returns may be made of the number, names, days' stay, age, sex, etc., of inmates, sources of income, and expenditure of the same, in detail, so that the cost of such institutions may be ascertained in order to have a basis on which grants may be made from the aforesaid Society to support such institutions, and that such reports be sent to the Corresponding Secretary of the General Board not later than the 1st of September each year.

15. The General Treasurer shall publish each quarter, in the Outlook, the moneys received by her.

16. Certificates of Membership may be granted to members of any Auxiliary who may be changing their place of residence, which shall
