



The scientific man who discovered and those who nave developed the Bessemer process of making steel have, according to the estimate of Abram S. Hewitt, added \$2,000,000,000 yearly to the world?'s wealth.

There is no reason except the imperfect adjustments of society why the lawyer should receive large rewards and the scientific man a scant salary. Those who render services to an-individual or group are likely to be paid in accordance with the value of their services to the individual or group; in our competitive system those who render services to society as a whole are not paid at all, or only partial-
