GERMAN AFTER CUE HORROR

Albert Paensgen, With Excellent Record in Europe, Will Try Luck at International Tournament in New York.

New York, N. Y., Feb. 7.—Albert Poensgen, the German entrant in the International amateur 182 lb. bantam championship tournament, which begins tonight in the concert hall of the Liederkreis, 539 West 58th street, Park avenue, arrived in this city yesterday. Mr. Poensgen came on the Kaiserin Augusta Victoria and was accompanied by his mother.

When he learned that he was to engage in his first match on the second night of the tournament, Wednesday, Mr. Poensgen requested that he be furnished with a practice partner at once. Before noon he was at work in the billiard room of the Liederkreis, playing against Dr. Edward Beck, a German physician, who was just off the steamer, he played excellently, making an average of a fraction above 20 for 300 points.

Dr. Beck is 35 years of age, is above 6 feet; slender, and dark. A follower of the game remarked: "He is certainly of the thoroughbred type of player, but he is not a champion, for one who can make a terrific finish for he is swift of stroke and sure."

The German champion said that he has been in the bantam ranks for years. His important tournament play had been in Paris, Munich and Liepsig.


