OVER FOUR HUNDRED TURNED OVER BY POLICE TO BE DEPORTED

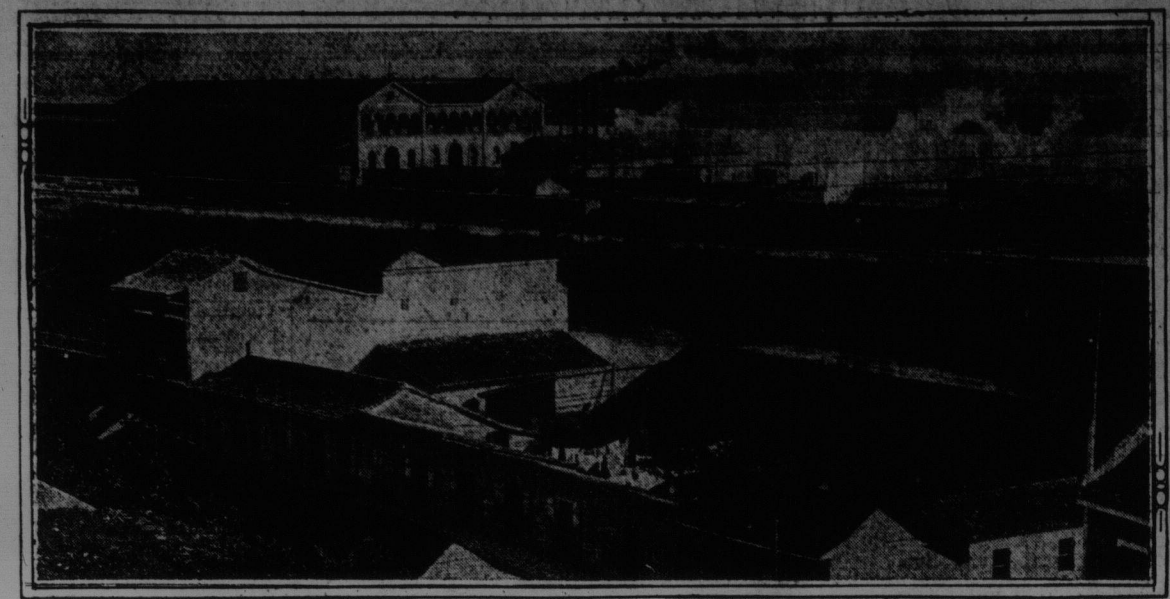
Campaign Against Undesirables Carried on Relentlessly by Provincial Police in Ontario Last Year.

During the six months, 417 undesirables were turned over to the Dominion immigration authorities for deportation, which is an increase of 24 over the same period last year.

WITH THE FALL OF TAMPICO TO REBELS MEXICO CITY LOSES ITS SUPPLY OF FUEL OIL



The constitutionalists, under General Pablo Gonzalez and General Luis Caballero, with 7,000 men, captured Tampico and entered the city as the federalists abandoned it. The supply of fuel oil, which comes from the Tampico district, now is cut off, and Mexico City is without means of obtaining fuel for railway locomotives or the industrial companies which operate their plants by means of fuel oil.

Nationalist Volunteers Claim to Have Discovered Plot on Part of Orangemen to Start Provisional Government.

London, May 21.—Light has been thrown upon the message sent the premier by the Nationalists of Derry promising assistance to prevent the establishment of a provisional government.

This plot came to light through an accident to a Carsonite emissary whose motor cycle skidded. Good Samaritans who helped the injured man became possessed of information which he was carrying, which, taken in conjunction with the great activity of a number of covered automobiles, stirred the Nationalists in the city to take instant measures to meet the situation.

Definite information concerning Carsonite plans to hold up Ulster is lacking, but interfering with transport communication services is apprehended as one of the principal moves.

SAYS INSINUATIONS WERE GROUNDESS

Halifax, N. S., May 20.—Mr. Tanner, leader of the opposition, moved a resolution in the House of Assembly today with reference to release of mortgage upon certain lands of Halifax and Southwestern Railway which was made basis of attack upon Attorney General Daniels in connection with suit started against him by A. D. Mills & Son's of Annapolis.

Hon. E. H. Armstrong showed that legislation authorizing release of mortgage had been in perfect order, had been partly drafted by H. McInnes, K. C., one of the leading Conservatives of Nova Scotia, and Tanner's insinuations were absolutely unfounded.

He challenged Mr. Tanner to substantiate his insinuations, but Mr. Tanner made no response. Attorney General Daniels gave detailed statement of Mills' case declared it was brought about by political conspiracy and produced admissions of another member of a firm that allegations made in affidavits were false and proved that suit had been settled on eve of trial after Mr. Mills had pleaded with him to save him from going into the witness box, declaring to Mr. Daniels that it was the most disgraceful act of his life.

GABRIELLE FARRINGTON OF TEAC

Nearly Three Millions Dollars Paid Out Since—Over \$80,000 in to Professors' Wives.

New York, May 20.—The Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching, founded by Andrew Carnegie, and with an endowment of \$10,000,000, to provide retiring allowances for teachers and officers of high institutions in the United States, has during its first year of operation, distributed a total of \$8,000,000, according to the annual report issued by its president, Dr. Pritchett, today.

The report for the year ending 1913 shows that \$2,000,000 was distributed in retiring allowances to teachers, and \$600,000 to their widows, during the year.

The number of allowances paid during the year was thirty-three, making a total of 140 allowances paid since the foundation was organized. The average annual allowance is \$1,700.
