



Placed at \$250,000,000. Washington, D. C. Jan. 19.—The first year of national prohibition cost the Government approximately \$380. 000,000 in the ions of revenue and the price paid for the enforcement of the volstead law, according to unofficial figures available today at the Treasury Department. This does not consider loss to dif-ferent States in seleon licensed and special taxes. Certain officials are of the opinion that the Elighteenth Amendment shut off more than \$1,000. 000,000 in contribution to Government operation, both State and national. So far as the Government is con-cerned the internal revenue received for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1919, on distilled apäris for beverage pur-poses taxes amounting to \$276,585,437. The' institution of the Elighteenth Amendment put an end to this source of revenue.
