the said Register had been kept pursuant to the Act passed by the Legislature of the late Province of Lower Canada, in the thirtyfifth year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Third, inituled, "An Act to establish the forms of Registers of Baptisms, Act of L. ...

5 " Marriages and Burials, to confirm and make valid in law the " Register of the Protestant Congregation of Christ-Church, Mon-" treal, and others which may have been informally kept, and to " afford the means of remedying omissions in former Registers," or of an Ordinance of the Legislature of the said late Province.

10 passed in the second year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Ordinance L. " Ordinance to facilitate the manner in which Registers of Bap-"tisms, Marriages and Burials, shall in future be numbered " and authenticated, in the Province of Lower Canada."

VII. Ministers keeping Registers pursuant to this Act, shall in Penalties on Ministers con-15 all respects comply with and be governed by the above recited travening the Act and Ordinance, and shall in case of disobedience to the said said Act. Act or the said Ordinance be liable to the penalties in like cases provided by the said Act, which penalties shall also be recoverable, paid, applied and accounted for, in the same manneras the 20 penalties by the said Act imposed are thereby directed to be paid, applied and accounted for.

VIII. Nothing herein contained shall affect or be construed to Rights of Her affect in any manner or way whatever, the rights of Her Majesty, Bayed. Majesty, &c., Her Heirs and Successors, or of any body politic or corporate, or 25 of any person or persons, except such only as are herein mentioned.

IX. This Act shall be held to be a Public Act.
