The University of New Brunswick in a surprise move to improve their Hockey program has offered substantial amounts of money to former N.H.L. greats Bobby Orr and Gordie Howie to enrol at UNB to play for the Varsity Red's. The Athletic department is also in the midsts of appealing the C.I.A.U.'s age restriction of varsity players, which is presently at 25 years old.

Sources revealed that because of the C.I.A.U. regulation concerning eligibility of "pro" status players in sports, they would only have to sit out 1 year before being allowed to play for a Canadian University Varsity program, but Orr and Howie have already done this. Unfortunately the C.I.A.U. has put a age restriction on varsity players, thus presently making Orr and Howie ineligible. "They will certainly have to try-out for the team, but we feel they can make it" said one source high up in the Athletic Department.

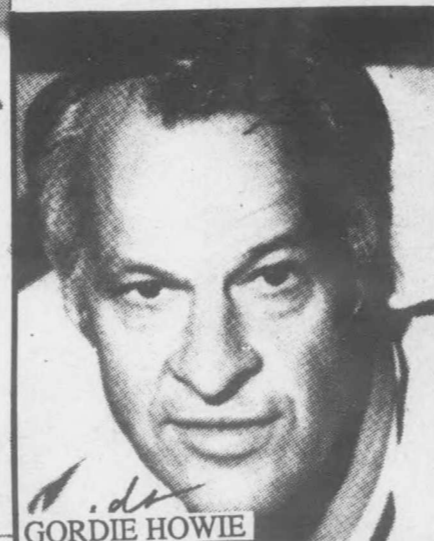
