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Ottawa, December 12, 1907.

Sir,-

In compliance with instructions of the 22, day of March last I left Ottawa on the 18, of April and having organized party made sub-division survey of portions of Indian reserves Nos. 72 and 73 at Broadview, in the Province of Saskatchewan.

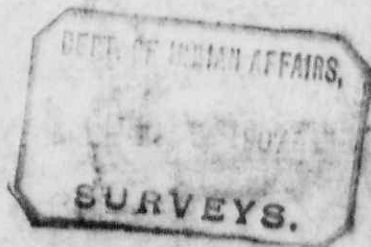
From Broadview proceeded to Mistawasis Indian reserve No. 103 and sub-divided the southerly portion of that reserve, thence to the Big River Indian reserve No. 118, laying off an addition to that reserve, cutting off the same area from the southwest corner of said reserve, No. 118.

From Big River reserve took outfit to Battleford and ran round the boundaries of the land assigned for the uses of the Battleford Industrial School.

From Battleford proceeded to Frog Lake and surveyed a fishing station for the Indians of reserve No. 121, cutting off an equal area from the southeast corner of that reserve.
