



Know all men by these presents that
Antoine Dupuis of the Township of Godmanchester in
Lower Canada, hath for and consideration of the full
and lawful sum of One Hundred Pounds Currency
of Lower Canada to him in hand paid by Ferguson
Mac Bear of the Township of Lancaster in Upper Canada
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to have been
received. Sold alienated conveyed transferred and forever
quit claims unto the said Ferguson Mac Bear all
his right title interest claims property and demand of
which he is now seized in consequence of a certain lease
of Indenture made to the said Antoine Dupuis by
the British Chiefs of the Tribe of St. Regis Indians for
all and singular that certain parcel space or tract
of land and tenement situate lying and being in the
Indian Reservation in Dundas Lower Canada for and
during the term of Ninety Nine years to be renewed for
another like term until the full end and term of One
Thousand years should be ended and completed for
the consideration of twenty four shillings yearly rent
to be paid to the said Chiefs, made and executed at
Dundas 16th October 1819 - signed by the Chiefs and witnessed
by William Mc Skirin and Signaux Hemodon
