
Ottawa, 26th July, 1915.

Sir:-

I beg to say that the necessary Order-in-Council has been passed authorizing the expenditure of \$125.00 in buying piping to convey water to the Lytton Reserve in accordance with request of Indians of 5th June, 1915.

The necessary material may be purchased and the work commenced at once. It is understood that the work will be done by the Indians interested without remuneration. Vouchers in duplicate for the lumber may be submitted for payment, and a report made to the Department on the work.
