



Ottawa, 30th April 1920.

Sir,-

Referring to your letter of the 29th ultimo I have to inform you that Mr. White, a surveyor of this Department, will proceed in a day or two to Cape Croker for the purpose of making a re-survey of the whole reserve. One or more members of the Council or men appointed by them should assist the surveyor throughout the whole work and you should engage such other Indians as he may require and render him any other assistance that may be in your power. Enclosed, for your information and guidance is a copy of the letter of instructions to Mr. White.
