8. Why the government believes it is entitled to the support of every Member who voted for Bill 80:

Because they endorsed the policy of the government in voting for that Bill and we have followed exactly the course we undertook to follow at that time.

9. Why the government believes it is entitled to
the support of every Member from the province
of Quebec who believes sincerely in the
unity and future of Canada as a nation:

Because we have respected to the utmost the feelings and sentiments of the minority - and have been prepared to endure five years of abuse and misrepresentation, and because the government continues to have in its ranks

Ministers from Quebec who will see that its point of view is vigorously and constantly put forward.

The only possible alternative government is clearly one in which the province of Quebec would not be represented by a responsible and
