

No. 80. Secret. My telegram No. 79, of today and my Circular telegram C. 27 of September 1st.

Naval Reserves.

Issue of Proclamation amounts to formal completion of mobilization procedure and all officers and men previously called up for service under the Reserve and the Auxiliary Forces Act of 1939 will henceforth serve as though mobilized by Royal Proclamation.

2. Prearranged telegram (see page 7 of 699 - M) is not in these direumstances, being sent and as regards question of action by Canadian Government as contemplated in C.B. 1799 this would not appear to be necessary except in so far as required either for administrative purposes or to complete final mobilization arrangements. Ends.
